

## **Details for Artist Members wishing to exhibit at the Fortingall Art 2010 exhibition**

There are 53 panels available for exhibitors. On the floor of the Hall the arrangement is for a 5 panel box, two coming out from the wall, a single panel at the end and then another two back to the wall, between each window. These boxes will be entirely secure and stable. On the stage there will be an "M" shape with 2 panels coming in from each side and 2 single panels forming the middle of the "M". All panels are very visible and there is a wide aisle down the middle.

To secure panels please contact Bill Bruce with a 50% deposit, cheques made out to "Fortingall Art" and sent to him ASAP. Panels will be allocated on a first come basis. Bill Bruce, Boltachan House, Weem, Aberfeldy PH15 2LA. If you have queries his email address is [bill\\_1\\_bruce@btinternet.com](mailto:bill_1_bruce@btinternet.com). He will be on holiday from March 8th for 2 weeks. I may well be able to answer any queries you may have prior to his return.

Jobs to be done Putting on the Exhibition requires manpower and involvement from the artists. If you have any time I am looking for a number of people to do discrete jobs, eg party for opening night, advertising, press releases. I am not expecting anyone to cater & will provide the info and background to what has happened in previous years although some new ideas would be most welcome.

Subscriptions for 2010 are also due, we have kept those at £10, and may be paid with your deposit for the panels.

Costs Each panel is 8ftx4ft, 32sq ft, and will have an overhead light and costs £30. Two new panels at 8ftx8ft will be 64sq ft for £60. As a comparison each of the previous panels was 3ftx6ft, 18sq ft; 3 of the old panels were 9ftx6ft, 54sq ft. So 2 new panels gives you significantly more space than 2 or even 3 of the old panels for the same money.
